### UNDERTAKING

**WHEREAS** 0731534 B.C. Ltd. *dba* Sukhi Bath Motors (Dealer #10431) (the "Dealer") is a "registered motor dealer" as defined under the *Motor Dealer Act* R.S.B.C. 1996 c. 316 (the "MDA").

**AND WHEREAS** the "Registrar of Motor Dealers", as defined under the Act, (the "Registrar") is responsible for the administration and enforcement of the Act, its regulations and prescribed provisions of the *Business Practices and Consumer Protection Act* S.B.C. 2004 c. 2 (the "BPCPA").

**AND WHEREAS** an investigation has been initiated involving the Dealer's conduct, and the following alleged contraventions of sections 4 and 5 of the BPCPA:

- 1. On or about September 27, 2014, at or near Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia, the Dealer did in relation to a consumer transaction contravene sections 4 and 5 of the BPCPA by making an oral, written, visual, descriptive or other representation or conduct to a consumer that had the capability, tendency or effect of misleading Gurmanpreet Hundal (the "Consumer") during the purchase of a 2014 Nissan Rogue VIN#5N1AT2MV5EC769852 (the "Motor Vehicle"). Specifically, the Dealer failed to:
  - Disclose to the Consumer at any time before, during or after the sale the true purpose of the solicitation was to have the Consumer purchase the Motor Vehicle for Raminderpal Gill; and
  - Disclose that the Consumer would be responsible for the full amount of the loan without the benefit of the Motor Vehicle.
- 2. On or about September 27, 2014, at or near Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia, the Dealer did in relation to a consumer transaction the following:

- contravene section 150(1)(e) of the BPCPA and section 35(3)(b) of the MDA, by failing to provide records to the Vehicle Sales Authority and/or Compliance Officer, Jas Virk, who is authorized by the Registrar to conduct investigations, that are related to the purchase of the Motor Vehicle.
- contravene section 35(3)(a) of the MDA by providing false statements to the Vehicle Sales Authority and/or Compliance Officer, Jas Virk, who is authorized by the Registrar to conduct investigations, that are related to the purchase of the Motor Vehicle; and
- contravene section 21(2) of the MDA *Regulation* by using a Motor Dealer Purchase Agreement that does not meet the legislated Requirements in relation to the sale of the Motor Vehicle.

**AND WHEREAS** the Dealer wishes to resolve these issues voluntarily, without a hearing, by entering into this Undertaking.

**AND WHEREAS** the Dealer has resolved the consumer monetary complaint to the satisfaction of the consumer and the Registrar by making the consumer whole again by reimbursing the consumer the amount of the purchase price of the Motor Vehicle.

#### THE DEALER HEREBY UNDERTAKES TO:

- a) To comply with the BPCPA and the regulations made there under;
- b) To ensure all consumers are aware of their rights, remedies and obligations prior to completion of the transaction;
- c) To provide complete records when requested by the VSA and/or a Compliance Officer acting on behalf of the Registrar;
- d) To maintain complete records of all Motor Vehicle transactions including but not limited to repairs, deposits, purchase agreements, inspections, buy ins and all other related documents; and

#### AND THERFORE THE DEALER UNDERTAKES TO:

- a) Reimburse the Registrar a total of \$1,027.98 for inspection/investigation and legal costs relating to the subject matter of this Undertaking; and
- b) Pay an Administrative Penalty in the amount of \$3,000.00 in relation to the issues covered in this Undertaking.

**THE UNDERSIGNED** hereby acknowledges, represents and declares that he or she has read this Undertaking and has had a reasonable opportunity to obtain independent legal advice as to its terms.

**THE UNDERSIGNED** further hereby acknowledges that the availability of an undertaking to resolve any future similar allegations or contraventions may be unavailable; and that any similar allegations may be reviewed by the Registrar of Motor Dealers at a formal hearing to consider the allegations.
