Forty wholesaler and two broker agent applications have been received to date. The Registry of Licensed Wholesalers and the Registry of Licensed Broker Agents are updated every Wednesday afternoon. As of April 1, a licensed dealer conducting business with an unlicensed wholesaler or broker agent will be aiding and abetting a violation of the Motor Dealer Act and may be subject to penalties and licence conditions.
