Continuing Education Deferral Expires October 1st Reminder to complete Continuing Education requirement by deadline

Those salespeople whose VSA licence was up for renewal between March and August of this year and have not completed their continuing education requirement have until October 1st to do so.

Due to the economic uncertainty surrounding the pandemic in March, the VSA temporarily extended the due date of CE Unit 5 to October 1, 2020 for those renewing their salesperson licence. Therefore, those who renewed their licence between March and August, but have not registered for and completed CE Unit 5, have a conditional licence expiry date of October 1st. Those renewing their licences in September and onwards must complete their CE Unit by the date indicated on the Conditional Letter they will receive with their licence renewal notice.

Salespeople can register for and access the online, self-study CE Unit 5 in 2 easy steps:



Registration

Simply by logging into their <u>Online Licensee Services Account</u> and click on *Continuing Education*,

or

Submit a Continuing Education Registration form



Access

Once their information has been processed, the salesperson will receive an email with a link and login instructions for the CE Unit.



Failure to complete the Continuing Education unit by the given deadline will lead to the Conditional Licence expiring and not being able to work as a salesperson until the requirements are met.
