Changes to Licensing Courses

Please note that the following changes to the Salesperson and Wholesaler Licensing course will be made effective November 23rd:

- Students will be <u>automatically registered</u> into the applicable course when their licence application has been processed, and they must complete and pass the course before their Conditional License expiry date
 Note: If a student has not completed or passed their course by their Conditional Licence expiry date, their Conditional Licence will become expired and the student may no longer act in the capacity of a salesperson
- Course refund requests that are provided in writing within 5 business days of course access will be issued, subject to the course refund schedule. Licensing fees remain non-refundable. For more details, <u>click here</u> for our complete course and refund policies
