

**COVID-19 CONSUMER GUIDELINES** 

## Test Drive Best Practices Checklist

This checklist is meant as a best practices guide when test driving vehicles at a licensed dealership during COVID-19.

Research your vehicle online – do a virtual tour of the vehicle with a licensed salesperson prior to the test drive

In order to meet physical distancing requirements, inquire if you can take the test drive without a salesperson present. The dealer may ask you to complete a <u>consent form like this</u> <u>example</u> for insurance purposes

Provide contact information including your email address and phone number in case contact tracing is required

Confirm with the salesperson that the vehicle is completely and effectively sanitized and disinfected prior to the test drive

Confirm that the vehicle is supplied with disinfectant for you to sanitize the surfaces you've touched after the test drive. Make sure to sanitize the surfaces you touch in the vehicle after the test drive

Receive and return vehicle keys only after disinfecting them
